Dear Early Childhood families,

I want to share with you an update regarding the beginning of our Early Childhood programs for the 2020-2021 school year. As we have moved closer to the start of our program, we have continued to evaluate our protocols for health and safety to determine how to safely transition to in-person offerings for our youngest learners. I am excited to share with you an adjustment we are implementing to make the transition earlier for our programs.

We are now scheduled to begin in-person instruction on September 21 for our Preschool, Nursery and Montessori classes. To accommodate stringent social distancing requirements, we will be reducing enrollment in these programs.

You will be receiving an email with important information such as Child Information Packets and schedules by Friday, September 4. We will also host a “Virtual” Parent/Child Welcome using the Zoom video conferencing software on Tuesday, September 15 for Nursery and Wednesday, September 16 for Preschoolers during your scheduled class time. We will review our health and safety protocols in depth at this meeting.
